SEI Confirmation on the Certification of FLIR K65 Thermal Imager

To Whom It May Concern:

The Safety Equipment Institute (SEI) has recently received an inquiry regarding the certification status of the FLIR K65 Thermal Imaging Camera to the NFPA 1801 *Standard on Thermal Imagers for the Fire Service*, 2021 Edition.

SEI confirms that the FLIR K65 Thermal Imager is currently certified to the NFPA 1801-2021 standard.

Currently, SEI is the only known certification body which is accredited to ISO 17065, *Conformity assessment – Requirements for bodies certifying products, processes and services*, for certifying thermal imaging cameras to the NFPA 1801 standard.

The best way to check the certification status of a particular model is to look on the SEI website's Certified Products List. This list is maintained in real time, meaning any product shown maintains an active certification.
